ANY KIND OF INFECTION CAN LEAD TO SEPSIS

Some common infections that can lead to sepsis include:

- URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS (UTIs)
- STREP THROAT ● INFLUENZA ● MRSA

Sepsis is your body's life-threatening response to an infection.

Sepsis is usually easy to treat if detected early.

Sepsis kills 270,000 people every year in the U.S.

If you've had an infection or suspect an infection, and develop a combination of these symptoms, seek medical attention right away:



TEMPERATURE

higher or lower
than normal



INFECTION

may have signs

MENTAL DECLINE

confused, sleepy,
difficult to rouse



EXTREMELY ILL
